The Project

This European project aims at:

- building the capacity of municipal staff, with a particular focus on managers of social services, frontline social workers and other service providers at the local level, in dealing with the multiple dimensions of long-term socio-economic inclusion of migrants and refugees;
- fostering and enhancing coordinated political engagement and commitment to promote inclusion and diversity in target municipalities, by increasing cooperation between local authorities and regional and national actors involved in policy development and service delivery;
- Enhancing the exchange of municipal experiences across the EU, by disseminating best practices and contextualized approaches to strengthening municipal services for migrants' inclusion.

Role of the Municipality of Piraeus

Within this context, the Municipality will facilitate the implementation of the following project activities by:

- Appointing a municipal employee as *focal point*, representing the Municipality to liaise with IOM in relation to project activities and coordinate project activities within the Municipality. The *focal point* will be responsible for: acting as the main interlocutor and resource person within the Municipality vis-à-vis IOM; informing the municipal staff participating in the trainings for the venue and dates of the trainings; promoting identified good practices within the Municipality structure.
- If needed, facilitating the trainings and/or events of the project by granting properly equipped municipal spaces for the duration of the training and or/event.
- Actively encouraging and incentivize municipal staff to participate in the trainings and implementing good practices and lessons learned.
- Consenting to the use of the Municipality logo in visibility materials produced within the framework of the project.
