Project

The MINE-EMI project focuses on the development of a joint educational program, which will be carried out by 4 Universities and which facilitates the development of skills and increases awareness of the emerging issues of shipping, with the ultimate goal of more sustainable management of the shipping sector. It focuses on the Black Sea basin and includes business and local government partners. Its purpose is to bridge the gap between shipping requirements (maritime management, shipping, etc.) and the current lack of training in these areas.

Stakeholders of the project are: students, academics, industry, society. During the implementation of the project, educational material will be developed by the University institutions, which will be evaluated according to the criteria of the interested parties. Then the educational material will be presented and evaluated by a selected audience during multiplier events.

Role of Municipality of Piraeus

The main objects of the Municipality of Piraeus during the implementation of the project are:

- the conduct of a survey that will identify the needs of stakeholders in matters of administration in maritime areas,
- the implementation of a multiplier event in which the produced educational material will be presented,
- the practical training of 12 students (3 from each University-partner) for five days in shipping
 companies, in matters of port and transport management, in the testing of the teaching method and the
 evaluation of the new thematic units that will be developed by the MINE EMI study program
